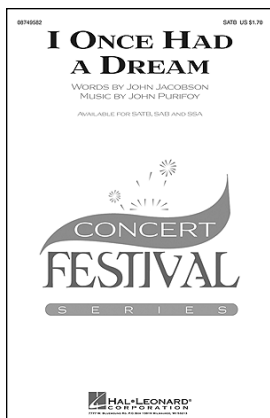


I ONCE HAD A DREAM

<u>Measure</u>	<u>Movement</u>
1	Heads down
3	Lift heads
5	Raise R fist slowly
6	Open fist and let hand drift down with palm up
8	Focus high downstage L
10	Move focus to audience
15	Raise focus to over audience heads
22	Lower focus to audience
23	Feet together, scoop both hands from low to chest level
25	Lower hands
27	Gather audience in with L hand
28	Gather audience in with R hand
	Bring both hands to chest on beat four
31	In four group peel off from stage L to R, step out with L foot
33	All bring L foot in so feet are together
35	Grab hands in long lines
36	Slowly raise held hands to shoulder height
38	Lower held hands
40	Let go of hands
44	Bring R hand to heart
49	Women present R hand L to R
51	Women leave hand at chest level, Men present R hand from L to R
54	All scoop L hand to match height of R
55	Scoop both hands to overhead
56	Burst both hands high to low with palms up
58	Scoop R fist
60	Open fist and let it float down
62	Look slowly from down to your R to high downstage L
67	Bring focus back to high center
69	Slowly bring both hands to heart
71	Open hands out from chest with palms up
72	Scoop hands from shoulder height up to high
73	Clench fists on beat four
74	Burst hands high to low
76	Continue to lower hands
80	Lift R fist, down on cue
